TANKRIS are four musicians from Vienna/Europe, all prolific in their own ways between improvised music, jazz, free form/noise-rock, rather not sticking with too clear defined or hollow genres in their work. Deceively set up as a regular rock combo, it turns out to be more of a convertible hybrid of rock history's unreleased b-sides: gonzo-beats meet whacky riffs to create a bizarre multiverse of exotic pop tunes.
